## 1 SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.

2 This Act may be cited as the "Permanent Internet3 Tax Freedom Act".

## 4 SEC. 2. PERMANENT MORATORIUM ON INTERNET ACCESS 5 TAXES AND MULTIPLE AND DISCRIMINATORY 6 TAXES ON ELECTRONIC COMMERCE.

7 (a) IN GENERAL.—Section 1101(a) of the Internet
8 Tax Freedom Act (47 U.S.C. 151 note) is amended by
9 striking "during the period beginning November 1, 2003,
10 and ending October 1, 2015".

(b) EFFECTIVE DATE.—The amendment made bythis section shall apply to taxes imposed after the dateof the enactment of this Act.
