A BILL

To amend the Food and Nutrition Act of 2008 to change the eligible foods allowed for purchase under the Supplemental Nutrition Assistance Program (commonly known as SNAP).

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 **SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.**

4 This Act may be cited as the “Nutritious Options for
5 Meals Act of 2015”.

1 **SEC. 2. AMENDMENT.**

2 Section 3(k)(1) of the Food and Nutrition Act of
3 2008 (7 U.S.C. 2012(k)(1)) is amended by striking “any
4 food” the first place it appears and all that follows
5 through “consumption” the last place it appears, and in-
6 serting the following: “a supplemental food of the kind
7 prescribed by the Secretary under section 17(b)(14) of the
8 Child Nutrition Act of 1966, or lean meat or poultry as
9 prescribed by the Secretary,”.

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
