A BILL

To designate the “PFC Milton A. Lee Medal of Honor
Memorial Highway” in the State of Texas.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 **SECTION 1. DESIGNATION.**

4 The segment of Interstate Route 10 between milepost
5 535 and milepost 545 at Kendall County, Texas, shall be

1 known and designated as the “PFC Milton A. Lee Medal
2 of Honor Memorial Highway”.

3 **SEC. 2. REFERENCES.**

4 Any reference in a law, map, regulation, document,
5 paper, or other record of the United States to the segment
6 of Interstate Route 10 referred to in section 1 shall be
7 deemed to be a reference to the “PFC Milton A. Lee
8 Medal of Honor Memorial Highway”.
