# **A BILL**

To improve and reauthorize provisions relating to the application of the antitrust laws to the award of need-based educational aid.

1       *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*  
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 **SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.**

4       This Act may be cited as the “Need-Based Edu-  
5 cational Aid Act of 2015”.

6 **SEC. 2. EXTENSION RELATING TO THE APPLICATION OF**  
7                   **THE ANTRITRUST LAWS TO THE AWARD OF**  
8                   **NEED-BASED EDUCATIONAL AID.**

9       Section 568 of the Improving America’s Schools Act  
10 of 1994 (15 U.S.C. 1 note) is amended—

11           (1) in subsection (a)—

12                   (A) in paragraph (2), by inserting “or”  
13 after the semicolon;

14                   (B) in paragraph (3), by striking “; or”  
15 and inserting a period at the end; and

16                   (C) by striking paragraph (4); and

17           (2) in subsection (d), by striking “2015” and  
18 inserting “2022”.
