A BILL

To amend title 23, United States Code, to repeal the transportation alternatives program, and for other purposes.

3 **SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.**

4 This Act may be cited as the “Right-of-Way for
5 American Drivers Act of 2015”.

6 **SEC. 2. REPEAL OF TRANSPORTATION ALTERNATIVES PRO-**
7 **GRAM.**

8 (a) IN GENERAL.—The following provisions of title
9 23, United States Code, are repealed:

10 (1) Section 101(a)(29).

1 (2) Section 133(b)(11).

2 (3) Section 213 (and the item relating to that
3 section in the analysis for chapter 1).

4 (b) APPLICABILITY.—The repeals made by subsection
5 (a) shall apply to fiscal years beginning after the date of
6 enactment of this Act.

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
