A BILL

To require the Secretary of the Treasury to redesign Federal reserve notes so as to include a likeness of Harriet Tubman, and for other purposes.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 **SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.**

4 This Act may be cited as the “Harriet Tubman Trib-
5 ute Act of 2015”.

1 **SEC. 2. LIKENESS OF HARRIET TUBMAN REQUIRED TO BE**
2 **INCLUDED ON THE FACE OF FEDERAL RE-**
3 **SERVE NOTES.**

4 The 8th undesignated paragraph of section 16 of the
5 Federal Reserve Act (12 U.S.C. 418) is amended by add-
6 ing at the end the following new sentence: “The Secretary
7 of the Treasury shall designate one of the foregoing de-
8 nominations and shall ensure that the face of all Federal
9 reserve notes of that denomination printed after December
10 31, 2017, shall bear the likeness of Harriet Tubman.”.
