A BILL

To authorize the Secretary of Veterans Affairs to recoup bonuses and awards paid to employees of the Department of Veterans Affairs.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 **SECTION 1. AUTHORITY TO RECOUP BONUSES OR AWARDS**

4 **PAID TO EMPLOYEES OF DEPARTMENT OF**
5 **VETERANS AFFAIRS.**

6 *(a) IN GENERAL.—Chapter 7 of title 38, United States*
7 *Code, is amended by adding at the end the following new*
8 *section:*

9 **“§ 715. Recoupment of bonuses or awards paid to em-**
10 **ployees of Department**

11 *“(a) RECOUPMENT.—Notwithstanding any other pro-*
12 *vision of law, the Secretary may issue an order directing*
13 *an employee of the Department to repay the amount, or*
14 *a portion of the amount, of any award or bonus paid to*
15 *the employee under title 5, including under chapters 45 or*
16 *53 of such title, or this title if—*

17 *“(1) the Secretary determines such repayment*
18 *appropriate pursuant to regulations prescribed under*
19 *subsection (c); and*

20 *“(2) before such repayment, the employee is af-*
21 *forded notice and an opportunity for a hearing con-*
22 *ducted by another department or agency of the Fed-*
23 *eral Government.*

1 “(b) *REVIEW.*—A decision regarding a repayment by
2 an employee pursuant to subsection (a)(2) is final and may
3 not be reviewed by any department or agency or any court.

4 “(c) *REGULATIONS.*—The Secretary shall prescribe
5 regulations to carry out this section.”.

6 (b) *CLERICAL AMENDMENT.*—The table of sections at
7 the beginning of such chapter is further amended by adding
8 at the end the following new item:

 “715. *Recoupment of bonuses or awards paid to employees of Department.*”.

9 (c) *EFFECTIVE DATE.*—Section 715 of title 38, United
10 States Code, as added by subsection (a), shall apply with
11 respect to an award or bonus paid by the Secretary of Vet-
12 erans Affairs to an employee of the Department of Veterans
13 Affairs before, on, or after the date of the enactment of this
14 Act.

15 (d) *CONSTRUCTION.*—Nothing in this Act or the
16 amendments made by this Act may be construed to modify
17 the certification issued by the Office of Personnel Manage-
18 ment and the Office of Management and Budget regarding
19 the performance appraisal system of the Senior Executive
20 Service of the Department of Veterans Affairs.
