A BILL

To reauthorize the Stem Cell Therapeutic and Research Act
of 2005, and for other purposes.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 **SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.**

4 This Act may be cited as the “Stem Cell Therapeutic
5 and Research Reauthorization Act of 2015”.

6 **SEC. 2. AMENDMENTS TO THE STEM CELL THERAPEUTIC**
7 **AND RESEARCH ACT OF 2005.**

8 (a) CORD BLOOD INVENTORY.—Section 2 of the
9 Stem Cell Therapeutic and Research Act of 2005 (42
10 U.S.C. 274k note) is amended in subsection (h)—

11 (1) in paragraph (1)—

12 (A) by striking “\$23,000,000 for each of
13 fiscal years 2011 through 2014 and”; and

14 (B) by inserting before the period at the
15 end the following: “and \$23,000,000 for each of
16 fiscal years 2016 through 2020”; and

17 (2) in paragraph (2), by striking “2011
18 through 2015” and inserting “2015 through 2020”.

19 (b) NATIONAL PROGRAM.—Section 379B of the Pub-
20 lic Health Service Act (42 U.S.C. 274m) is amended by
21 striking “2011 through 2014” and inserting “2016
22 through 2020”.

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
