## A BILL

To amend the Fair Labor Standards Act of 1938 to expand the number of employers required to provide a reasonable time and place for employees to express milk at the workplace.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*  
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

1 **SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE. This Act may be cited as the “Fair**  
2 **Access for Moms Act”.**

3 **SEC. 2. EMPLOYERS REQUIRED TO PROVIDE REASONABLE**  
4 **TIME AND PLACE FOR EXPRESSING MILK.**

5 Section 7(r)(3) of the Fair Labor Standards Act of  
6 1938 (29 U.S.C. 207(r)(3)) is amended by striking  
7 “50”and inserting “15”.
