A BILL

To facilitate the addition of park administration at the
Coltsville National Historical Park, and for other purposes.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 **SECTION 1. AMENDMENT TO COLTSVILLE NATIONAL HIS-**
4 **TORICAL PARK DONATION SITE.**

5 *Section 3032(b) of Public Law 113–291 (16 U.S.C.*
6 *410qqq) is amended—*

7 *(1) in paragraph (2)(B), by striking “East Ar-*
8 *mory” and inserting “Colt Armory Complex”; and*

9 *(2) by adding at the end the following:*

10 *“(4) ADDITIONAL ADMINISTRATIVE CONDI-*
11 *TIONS.—No non-Federal property may be included in*
12 *the park without the written consent of the owner.*
13 *The establishment of the park or the management of*
14 *the park shall not be construed to create buffer zones*
15 *outside of the park. That activities or uses can be*
16 *seen, heard or detected from areas within the park*
17 *shall not preclude, limit, control, regulate, or deter-*
18 *mine the conduct or management of activities or uses*
19 *outside of the park.”.*

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
