A BILL

To enhance the energy security of United States allies, and
for other purposes.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 **SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.**

4 This Act may be cited as the “American Job Creation
5 and Strategic Alliances LNG Act”.

1 **SEC. 2. AMENDMENTS.**

2 Section 3(c) of the Natural Gas Act (15 U.S.C.
3 717b(c)) is amended—

4 (1) by inserting “(1)” before “For purposes”;

5 (2) by striking “a nation with which there is in
6 effect a free trade agreement requiring national
7 treatment for trade in natural gas” and inserting “a
8 World Trade Organization member nation”; and

9 (3) by adding at the end the following:

10 “(2) For purposes of this subsection, the term ‘World
11 Trade Organization member nation’ means a country de-
12 scribed in section 2(10) of the Uruguay Round Agree-
13 ments Act (19 U.S.C. 3501(10)).”.

14 **SEC. 3. PENDING APPLICATIONS.**

15 The amendments made by section 2 shall apply with
16 respect to applications for the authorization to export nat-
17 ural gas under section 3 of the Natural Gas Act (15
18 U.S.C. 717b) that are pending on, or filed on or after,
19 the date of enactment of this Act.

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
