A BILL

To prohibit the receipt of Federal financial assistance by
sanctuary cities, and for other purposes.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 **SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.**

4 This Act may be cited as the “Sanctuary City All
5 Funding Elimination Act of 2015” or the “SAFE Act of
6 2015”.

1 **SEC. 2. NO FEDERAL FINANCIAL ASSISTANCE FOR SANC-**
2 **TUARY CITIES.**

3 Any State or local government that is not in compli-
4 ance with section 642 of the Illegal Immigration Reform
5 and Immigrant Responsibility Act of 1996 (8 U.S.C.
6 1373) may not receive any Federal financial assistance (as
7 such term is defined in section 7501(a)(5) of title 31,
8 United States Code) until the State or local government
9 has produced a comprehensive plan to come back into
10 compliance with such section 642.

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
