## A BILL

To provide enhanced security at Armed Forces recruitment centers through the installation of reinforced bullet-proof glass and entry doors.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*  
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 **SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.**

4 This Act may be cited as the “Armed Forces Career  
5 Center Protection Act”.

1 **SEC. 2. INSTALLATION OF REINFORCED BULLET-PROOF**  
2 **GLASS AND ENTRY DOORS AT ARMED**  
3 **FORCES RECRUITMENT CENTERS.**

4 The Secretary of each of the military departments,  
5 and the Secretary of the Department in which the Coast  
6 Guard is operating, shall provide for the installation of  
7 reinforced bullet-proof glass and entry doors at Armed  
8 Forces recruitment centers, including facilities leased for  
9 use as recruitment centers, under the jurisdiction of the  
10 Secretary as an additional security measure to protect  
11 members of the Armed Forces serving as recruiters and  
12 potential recruits and other individuals visiting recruit-  
13 ment centers.
