#### 1 SECTION 1. VEHICULAR ACCESS AND FEES.

2 Section 4 of the Delaware Water Gap National Recre3 ation Area Improvement Act (Public Law 109–156) is
4 amended to read as follows:

## 5 "SEC. 4. USE OF CERTAIN ROADS WITHIN THE RECREATION 6 AREA.

7 "(a) IN GENERAL.—Except as otherwise provided in
8 this section, Highway 209, a federally owned road within
9 the boundaries of the Recreation Area, shall be closed to
10 all commercial vehicles.

"(b) EXCEPTION FOR LOCAL BUSINESS USE.—Until
September 30, 2020, subsection (a) shall not apply with
respect to the use of commercial vehicles that have four
or fewer axles and are—

15 "(1) owned and operated by a business phys16 ically located in—

- 17 "(A) the Recreation Area; or
- 18 "(B) one or more adjacent municipalities;

"(B) one of more adjacent municipalities.
"(c) FEE.—The Secretary shall establish a fee and
permit program for the use by commercial vehicles of
Highway 209 under subsection (b). The program shall in-

clude an annual fee not to exceed \$200 per vehicle. All
 fees received under the program shall be set aside in a
 special account and be available, without further appro priation, to the Secretary for the administration and en forcement of the program, including registering vehicles,
 issuing permits and vehicle identification stickers, and
 personnel costs.

8 "(d) EXCEPTIONS.—The following vehicles may use
9 Highway 209 and shall not be subject to a fee or permit
10 requirement under subsection (c):

11 "(1) Local school buses.

12 "(2) Fire, ambulance, and other safety and13 emergency vehicles.

14 "(3) Commercial vehicles using Federal Road
15 Route 209, from—

"(A) Milford to the Delaware River Bridge
leading to U.S. Route 206 in New Jersey; and
"(B) mile 0 of Federal Road Route 209 to
Pennsylvania State Route 2001.".

#### 20 SEC. 2. DEFINITIONS.

Section 2 of the Delaware Water Gap National Recreation Area Improvement Act (Public Law 109–156) is
amended—

(1) by redesignating paragraphs (1) through
(5) as paragraphs (2) through (6), respectively; and

(2) by inserting before paragraph (2) (as so re designated by paragraph (1) of this section) the fol lowing:

4 "(1) ADJACENT MUNICIPALITIES.—The term
5 'adjacent municipalities' means Delaware Township,
6 Dingman Township, Lehman Township, Matamoras
7 Borough, Middle Smithfield Township, Milford Bor8 ough, Milford Township, Smithfield Township and
9 Westfall Township, in Pennsylvania.".

#### 10 SEC. 3. CONFORMING AMENDMENT.

Section 702 of the Omnibus Parks and Public Lands
Management Act of 1996 (Public Law 104–333) is repealed.
