A BILL

To amend the Immigration and Nationality Act to allow labor organizations and management organizations to receive the results of visa petitions about which such organizations have submitted advisory opinions, and for other purposes.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 **SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.**

4 This Act may be cited as the “Oversee Visa Integrity
5 with Stakeholder Advisories Act” or the “O-VISA Act”.

1 **SEC. 2. ALLOWING CERTAIN ORGANIZATIONS TO RECEIVE**
2 **THE RESULTS OF VISA PETITIONS.**

3 Section 214(e) of the Immigration and Nationality
4 Act (8 U.S.C. 1184(e)) is amended—

5 (1) in paragraph (3)—

6 (A) by striking “Attorney General” each
7 place it appears and inserting “Secretary of
8 Homeland Security”; and

9 (B) in the first sentence of the matter fol-
10 lowing subparagraph (B)—

11 (i) by striking “and (iv)” and insert-
12 ing “(iv)”; and

13 (ii) by striking the period at the end
14 and inserting the following: “, and (v)
15 upon making the decision, the Secretary of
16 Homeland Security shall provide a copy of
17 the decision to the organizations consulted
18 with under subparagraph (A) or (B).”;

19 (2) in paragraph (8), by adding at the end the
20 following:

21 “(F) With respect to petitions under subpara-
22 graph (O)(i) of such section with regard to motion
23 picture and television productions—

24 “(i) the number of such petitions which
25 have been filed;

1 “(ii) the number of petitions described in
2 clause (i) that include opinions or involve con-
3 sultations that recommend denial and, of such
4 number, the number that were approved; and

5 “(iii) the number of petitions described in
6 clause (i) that include opinions or involve con-
7 sultations that recommend approval that were
8 filed and, of such number, the number that
9 were approved.”.
