1 SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.

2	This Act may be cited as the "Good Samaritan					
3	Search and Recovery Act".					
4	SEC. 2. EXPEDITED ACCESS TO CERTAIN FEDERAL LAND.					
5	(a) DEFINITIONS.—In this section:					
6	(1) Eligible.—The term "eligible", with re					
7	spect to an organization or individual, means that					
8	the organization or individual, respectively, is—					
9	(A) acting in a not-for-profit capacity; and					
10	(B) composed entirely of members who, a					
11	the time of the good Samaritan search-and-re-					
12	covery mission, have attained the age of major-					
13	ity under the law of the State where the mis-

15	(2) GOOD SAMARITAN SEARCH-AND-RECOVERY

9	(c) Release of Federal Government From Li-
10	ABILITY.—The Secretary shall not require an eligible or-
11	ganization or individual to have liability insurance as a
12	condition of accessing Federal land under this section, if
13	the eligible organization or individual—
14	(1) acknowledges and consents, in writing, to
15	the provisions described in subparagraphs (A)
16	through (D) of subsection (b)(2); and
17	(2) signs a waiver releasing the Federal Gov-
18	ernment from all liability relating to the access
19	granted under this section and agrees to indemnify
20	and hold harmless the United States from any
21	claims or lawsuits arising from any conduct by the
22	eligible organization or individual on Federal land.
23	(d) APPROVAL AND DENIAL OF REQUESTS.—
24	(1) In general.—The Secretary shall notify

an eligible organization or individual of the approval

- or denial of a request by the eligible organization or individual to carry out a good Samaritan searchand-recovery mission under this section by not later than 48 hours after the request is made.
 - (2) Denials.—If the Secretary denies a request from an eligible organization or individual to carry out a good Samaritan search-and-recovery mission under this section, the Secretary shall notify the eligible organization or individual of—
- 10 (A) the reason for the denial of the re-11 quest; and
- 12 (B) any actions that the eligible organiza-13 tion or individual can take to meet the require-14 ments for the request to be approved.
- 15 (e) Partnerships.—Each Secretary shall develop 16 search-and-recovery-focused partnerships with search-and-17 recovery organizations—
 - (1) to coordinate good Samaritan search-andrecovery missions on Federal land under the administrative jurisdiction of the Secretary; and
 - (2) to expedite and accelerate good Samaritan search-and-recovery mission efforts for missing individuals on Federal land under the administrative jurisdiction of the Secretary.
