## A BILL

To amend the Internal Revenue Code of 1986 to allow the Secretary of the Treasury to withhold social security numbers on Form 990 from public disclosure.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*  
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 **SECTION 1. AUTHORITY TO WITHHOLD SOCIAL SECURITY**  
4 **ACCOUNT NUMBERS ON FORM 990 FROM PUB-**  
5 **LIC DISCLOSURE.**

6 (a) INSPECTION OF ANNUAL RETURNS.—Section  
7 6104(b) of the Internal Revenue Code of 1986 is amended  
8 by adding at the end the following: “The Secretary may  
9 withhold from public inspection any social security account

1 number included in information required to be made avail-  
2 able under this subsection.”.

3 (b) PUBLIC INSPECTION OF CERTAIN ANNUAL RE-  
4 TURNS, REPORTS, APPLICATIONS FOR EXEMPTION, AND  
5 NOTICES OF STATUS.—Section 6104(d)(3)(B) of such  
6 Code is amended by adding at the end the following: “or  
7 disclosure of any social security account number included  
8 in information required to be made available under this  
9 subsection.”.

10 (c) EFFECTIVE DATE.—The amendments made by  
11 this section shall apply with respect to disclosures made  
12 after the date of the enactment of this Act.
