A BILL

To amend title 18, United States Code, to prohibit the sale of firearms to individuals suspected of terrorism, and for other purposes.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 **SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.**

4 This Act may be cited as the “No Guns for Terrorists
5 Act of 2015”.

6 **SEC. 2. PROHIBITING THE SALE OF FIREARMS TO INDIVID-**
7 **UALS SUSPECTED OF TERRORISM.**

8 Section 922(d) of title 18, United States Code, is
9 amended by adding at the end the following: “It shall be
10 unlawful for any person to sell or otherwise dispose of any

1 firearm or ammunition to any person knowing or having
2 reasonable cause to believe that such person is, in the de-
3 termination of the Attorney General, a person who is
4 known to have, or appropriately suspected to have, en-
5 gaged in conduct constituting terrorism, conduct in prepa-
6 ration for terrorism, conduct in aid of terrorism, or con-
7 duct that is otherwise unlawful and related to terrorism.”.
