6 PHYSICIANS EMPLOYED BY THE DEPART7 MENT OF VETERANS AFFAIRS.

8 Section 7423(a) of title 38, United States Code, is

10 (1) by striking "(a) The hours" and inserting
11 "(a)(1) Except as provided in paragraph (2), the

13 (2) by adding at the end the following new14 paragraph:

15 ((2)(A) Upon the advance written request of a cov-16 ered physician, the Secretary may modify the hours of employment for a physician appointed in the Administration 17 under any provision of this chapter on a full-time basis 18 19 to be more or less than 80 hours in a biweekly pay period, 20 subject to the requirements in subparagraph (B). For the purpose of determining pay, such a physician shall be 21 22 deemed to have a biweekly schedule of 80 hours of employ-23 ment.

24 "(B) A physician with an irregular work schedule es25 tablished under subparagraph (A) shall be obligated to ac26 count for at least 2,080 hours of employment (through -HR 4150 EH

performance of work or use of leave or paid time off) in
 a calendar year.

3 "(C) The Secretary may prescribe regulations to im-4 plement this paragraph, including regulations making ad-5 justments to address the annual hours requirement for 6 physicians who are covered by this paragraph for only a 7 portion of a calendar year.".
