- 6 (a) Reports Required.—Not later than 60 days
- 7 after the date of the enactment of this Act, and every 180
- 8 days thereafter, the Director of National Intelligence, con-

- 10 methods, shall submit to the appropriate congressional
- 11 committees a report on foreign fighter flows to and from

- 13 (b) Contents.—Each report submitted under sub-
- 14 section (a) shall include, with respect to each terrorist safe
- 15 haven, the following:
- 16 (1) The total number of foreign fighters who
- have traveled or are suspected of having traveled to
- the terrorist safe haven since 2011, including the
- countries of origin of such foreign fighters.

- 25 (c) FORM.—The reports submitted under subsection
