Mr. SAM JOHNSON of Texas introduced the following bill; which was referred to the Committee on the Judiciary

A BILL

To prohibit the admission of K–1 nonimmigrants and to prohibit the issuance of K–1 visas, and for other purposes.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 **SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.**

4 This Act may be cited as the “K–1 Visa Program
5 Suspension Act of 2015”.

6 **SEC. 2. LIMITATION ON ADMISSION OF K–1 NON-**
7 **IMMIGRANTS.**

8 (a) MORATORIUM ON K–1 VISA ISSUANCE.—Begin-
9 ning on the date of enactment of this Act, no alien may
10 be admitted to the United States under section

1 101(a)(15)(K)(i) of the Immigration and Nationality Act
2 (8 U.S.C. 1101(a)(15)(K)(i)) and no visas under such sec-
3 tion may be issued.

4 (b) GAO REPORT.—Not later than 180 days after
5 the date of enactment of this Act, the Comptroller General
6 of the United States shall conduct a review of the national
7 security risks associated with the admission of aliens
8 under the K–1 visa program and submit the results of that
9 review to the Congress.
