AN ACT

To require the Administrator of the Small Business Administration to issue regulations providing examples of a failure to comply in good faith with the requirements of prime contractors with respect to subcontracting plans.

- 1 Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-
- 2 tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,

1 SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.

- This Act may be cited as the "Service Provider Op-
- 3 portunity Clarification Act of 2015".
- 4 SEC. 2. GOOD FAITH COMPLIANCE WITH THE REQUIRE-
- 5 MENTS OF PRIME CONTRACTORS WITH RE-
- 6 SPECT TO SUBCONTRACTING PLANS.
- 7 Not later than 270 days after the date of enactment
- 8 of this Act, the Administrator of the Small Business Ad-
- 9 ministration shall issue regulations providing examples of
- 10 activities that would be considered a failure to make a
- 11 good faith effort to comply with the requirements imposed
- 12 on an entity (other than a small business concern as de-
- 13 fined under section 3 of the Small Business Act (15
- 14 U.S.C. 632)) that is awarded a prime contract containing
- 15 the clauses required under paragraphs (4) or (5) of section
- 16 8(d) of the Small Business Act (15 U.S.C. 637(d)).
