#### **AN ACT**

- To amend title 38, United States Code, to provide for the burial in Arlington National Cemetery of the cremated remains of certain persons whose service has been determined to be active service.
  - 1 Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-
  - 2 tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,

SECTION 1. BURIAL OF CREMATED REMAINS IN ARLING TON NATIONAL CEMETERY OF CERTAIN PER SONS WHOSE SERVICE IS DEEMED TO BE AC TIVE SERVICE.

5 (a) IN GENERAL.—Section 2410 of title 38, United
6 States Code, is amended by adding at the end the fol7 lowing new subsection:

8 "(c)(1) The Secretary of the Army shall ensure that 9 under such regulations as the Secretary may prescribe, the 10 cremated remains of any person described in paragraph 11 (2) are eligible for inurnment in Arlington National Ceme-12 tery with military honors in accordance with section 1491 13 of title 10.

"(2) A person described in this paragraph is a person
whose service has been determined to be active duty service pursuant to section 401 of the GI Bill Improvement
Act of 1977 (Public Law 95–202; 38 U.S.C. 106 note)
as of the date of the enactment of this paragraph.".

19 (b) Applicability.—

20 (1) IN GENERAL.—The amendment made by
21 subsection (a) shall apply with respect to—

(A) the remains of a person that are not
formally interred or inurned as of the date of
the enactment of this Act; and

25 (B) a person who dies on or after the date26 of the enactment of this Act.

1 (2) FORMALLY INTERRED OR INURNED DE-2 FINED.—In this subsection, the term "formally in-3 terred or inurned" means interred or inurned in a 4 cemetery, crypt, mausoleum, columbarium, niche, or 5 other similar formal location.

### 6 SEC. 2. REPORT ON CAPACITY OF ARLINGTON NATIONAL 7 CEMETERY.

8 Not later than 180 days after the date of the enact-9 ment of this Act, the Secretary of the Army shall submit 10 to the Committees on Veterans' Affairs and the Commit-11 tees on Armed Services of the House of Representatives 12 and the Senate a report on the interment and inurnment 13 capacity of Arlington National Cemetery, including—

14 (1) the estimated date that the Secretary deter15 mines the cemetery will reach maximum interment
16 and inurnment capacity; and

17 (2) in light of the unique and iconic meaning of 18 the cemetery to the United States, recommendations 19 for legislative actions and nonlegislative options that 20 the Secretary determines necessary to ensure that 21 the maximum interment and inurnment capacity of 22 the cemetery is not reached until well into the fu-23 ture, including such actions and options with respect 24 to---

1	(A) redefining eligibility criteria for inter-
2	ment and inurnment in the cemetery; and
3	(B) considerations for additional expansion
4	opportunities beyond the current boundaries of
5	the cemetery.
