## A BILL

To amend title 38, United States Code, to provide for the burial of the cremated remains of persons who served as Women's Air Forces Service Pilots in Arlington National Cemetery.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*  
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

1 **SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.**

2 This Act may be cited as the “Women Airforce Serv-  
3 ice Pilot Arlington Inurnment Restoration Act.”.

4 **SEC. 2. BURIAL OF CREMATED REMAINS OF WOMEN’S AIR**  
5 **FORCES SERVICE PILOTS IN ARLINGTON NA-**  
6 **TIONAL CEMETERY.**

7 (a) IN GENERAL.—Section 2410 of title 38, United  
8 States Code, is amended by adding at the end the fol-  
9 lowing new subsection:

10 “(c)(1) The Secretary of the Army shall ensure that  
11 under such regulations as the Secretary may prescribe, the  
12 cremated remains of any person described in paragraph  
13 (2) are eligible for interment in Arlington National Ceme-  
14 tery with full military honors.

15 “(2) A person described in this paragraph is a person  
16 whose service as a member of the Women’s Air Forces  
17 Service Pilots is considered to be active duty service pursu-  
18 ant to section 401 of the GI Bill Improvement Act of 1977  
19 (Public Law 95–202; 38 U.S.C. 106 note).”.

20 (b) APPLICABILITY.—The amendment made by sub-  
21 section (a) shall apply with respect to a person who dies  
22 before, on, or after the date of the enactment of this Act.
