A BILL

To withdraw certain lands in Los Angeles County, California, from entry, appropriation, or disposal under the public land laws, and for other purposes.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 **SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.**

4 This Act may be cited as the “Soledad Canyon Con-
5 sistency Act”.

1 **SEC. 2. WITHDRAWAL OF CERTAIN LANDS IN LOS ANGELES**
2 **COUNTY, CALIFORNIA.**

3 (a) WITHDRAWAL FROM MINERAL ENTRY.—Subject
4 to valid existing rights, if any, the lands described in sub-
5 section (b) are withdrawn from—

6 (1) entry, appropriation, or disposal under the
7 public land laws;

8 (2) location, entry, and patent under the mining
9 laws; and

10 (3) operation of the mineral leasing, mineral
11 materials, and geothermal leasing laws.

12 (b) LANDS DESCRIBED.—

13 (1) IN GENERAL.—The lands referred to in sub-
14 section (a) consist of approximately 640.16 acres de-
15 picted as “Soledad Canyon Sand & Gravel Mining
16 Project Site” on the Bureau of Land Management
17 map entitled “Soledad Canyon Map A” and dated
18 January 21, 2016.

19 (2) EFFECT.—The map referred to in para-
20 graph (1) shall have the same force and effect as if
21 included in this Act, except that the Secretary of the
22 Interior may correct minor errors in the map.

23 (3) AVAILABILITY.—The Secretary shall make
24 the map referred to in paragraph (1) available in the

1 appropriate offices of the Bureau of Land Manage-
2 ment.

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
