- 4 SEC. 2. ASSESSMENT AND ANALYSIS OF OUTDOOR RECRE-

- 6 (a) Assessment and Analysis.—The Secretary of
- 7 Commerce shall enter into a joint memorandum with the
- 8 Secretary of Agriculture and the Secretary of the Interior
- 9 to conduct, acting through the Director of the Bureau of
- 10 Economic Analysis, an assessment and analysis of the out-
- 11 door recreation economy of the United States and the ef-
- 12 fects attributable to such economy on the overall economy
- 13 of the United States.
- 14 (b) Considerations.—In conducting the assess-
- 15 ment required by subsection (a), the Secretary of Com-
- 16 merce may consider employment, sales, and contributions
- 17 to travel and tourism, and such other contributing compo-
- 18 nents of the outdoor recreation economy of the United
- 19 States as the Secretary considers appropriate.
- 20 (c) Consultation.—In carrying out the assessment
- 21 required by subsection (a), the Secretary of Commerce
- 22 shall consult with—
- 23 (1) the heads of such agencies and offices of
- the Federal Government as the Secretary considers
- appropriate, including the Secretary of Agriculture,
- the Secretary of the Interior, the Federal Recreation

4	(2) representatives of businesses, including					
5	small business concerns, that engage in commerce in					
6	the outdoor recreation economy of the United

8	(d) Report.—					
9	(1) In general.—Not later than 2 years after					
10	the date of the enactment of this Act, the Secretary					
11	of Commerce shall submit to the appropriate com-					
12	mittees of Congress a report on the findings of the					
13	Secretary with respect to the assessment conducted					
14	under subsection (a).					
15	(2) Appropriate committees of con-					
16	GRESS.—In this subsection, the term "appropriate					
17	committees of Congress" means—					
18	(A) the Committee on Commerce, Science,					
19	and Transportation of the Senate;					
20	(B) the Committee on Environment and					
21	Public Works of the Senate;					
22	(C) the Committee on Energy and Natural					
23	Resources of the Senate;					
24	(D) the Committee on Small Business and					
25	Entrepreneurship of the Senate:					

1	(E) the Committee on Energy and Com-						
2	merce of the House of Representatives; and						
3	(F) the Committee on Small Business of						
4	the House of Representatives.						
5	(e) Small Business Concern Defined.—In this						
6	section, the term "small business concern" has the mean-						
7	ing given such term under section 3 of the Small Business						
8	Act (15 U.S.C. 632).						
9	(f) No Additional Funds Authorized.—No addi-						
10	tional funds are authorized to carry out the requirements						
11	of this Act. Such requirements shall be carried out using						
12	amounts otherwise authorized.
