Ms. DUCKWORTH (for herself and Ms. CLARK of Massachusetts) introduced the following bill; which was referred to the Committee on Education and the Workforce

A BILL

To amend the Higher Education Act of 1965 to provide greater support to students with dependents, and for other purposes.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 **SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.**

4 This Act may be cited as the “Child Care Access
5 Means Parents in School Reauthorization Act” or the
6 “CCAMPIS Reauthorization Act”.

7 **SEC. 2. AMENDMENTS TO CCAMPIS.**

8 Section 419N of the Higher Education Act of 1965
9 (20 U.S.C. 1070e) is amended—

1 (1) in subsection (e)—

2 (A) in paragraph (1), by amending sub-
3 paragraph (B) to read as follows:

4 “(B) CONTENTS.—To ensure that the re-
5 ports submitted under paragraph (1) collect rel-
6 evant data on the program under this section
7 and its impact, the Secretary shall determine
8 the contents of such reports after consultation
9 with relevant stakeholders.”; and

10 (B) by adding at the end the following:

11 “(3) PUBLICATION OF REPORTS.—Not later
12 than 1 year after the first report is submitted under
13 paragraph (1), as amended by the CCAMPIS Reau-
14 thorization Act, and annually thereafter, the Sec-
15 retary shall publish the reports submitted under
16 paragraph (1) for the preceding year on the public
17 website of the Department.”; and

18 (2) by amending subsection (g) to read as fol-
19 lows:

20 “(g) AUTHORIZATION OF APPROPRIATIONS.—There
21 are authorized to be appropriated to carry out this section
22 \$67,000,000 for fiscal year 2017 and each succeeding fis-
23 cal year.”.

1 **SEC. 3. REPORT BY OFFICE OF POSTSECONDARY EDU-**
2 **CATION.**

3 Not later than 1 year after the date of enactment
4 of this Act, the Secretary of Education (acting through
5 the Office of Postsecondary Education) shall report to
6 Congress on the plans of the Department of Education
7 to better serve postsecondary students with dependents.
