A BILL

To repeal the Advanced Technology Vehicles Manufacturing Incentive Program.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 **SECTION 1. ADVANCED TECHNOLOGY VEHICLES MANUFAC-**
4 **TURING INCENTIVE PROGRAM REPEAL.**

5 (a) CESSATION OF AUTHORITY.—Effective on the
6 date of enactment of this Act, the Secretary of Energy
7 may not make any additional awards or loans under sec-
8 tion 136 of the Energy Independence and Security Act
9 of 2007 (42 U.S.C. 17013).

1 (b) REPEAL.—Upon the repayment, in accordance
2 with the terms of the loan agreements, of all loans made
3 before the date of enactment of this Act under subsection
4 (d) of such section, section 136 of the Energy Independ-
5 ence and Security Act of 2007 (42 U.S.C. 17013) is re-
6 pealed.
