AN ACT

To amend title 5, United States Code, to expand law enforcement availability pay to employees of U.S. Customs and Border Protection's Air and Marine Operations.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

1 **SECTION 1. LAW ENFORCEMENT AVAILABILITY PAY FOR**
2 **EMPLOYEES OF CUSTOMS AND BORDER PRO-**
3 **TECTION’S AIR AND MARINE OPERATIONS.**

4 (a) IN GENERAL.—Section 5545a(i) of title 5, United
5 States Code, is amended—

6 (1) by striking “apply to a pilot employed by
7 the United States Customs Service” and inserting
8 “apply to any employee of the U.S. Customs and
9 Border Protection’s Air and Marine Operations, or
10 any successor organization,”; and

11 (2) by striking “such pilot” and inserting “such
12 employee”.

13 (b) APPLICABILITY.—The amendments made by sub-
14 section (a) shall take effect on the first day of the first
15 applicable pay period beginning on or after the date that
16 is 14 days after the date of enactment of this Act.
