A BILL

To amend title 5, United States Code, to clarify the eligibility of employees of a land management agency in a time-limited appointment to compete for a permanent appointment at any Federal agency, and for other purposes.

2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 **SECTION 1. ELIGIBILITY OF EMPLOYEES IN A TIME-LIM-**
4 **ITED APPOINTMENT TO COMPETE FOR A**
5 **PERMANENT APPOINTMENT AT ANY FED-**
6 **ERAL AGENCY.**

7 Section 9602 of title 5, United States Code, is
8 amended—

9 (1) in subsection (a) by striking “any land
10 management agency or any other agency (as defined
11 in section 101 of title 31) under the internal merit
12 promotion procedures of the applicable agency” and
13 inserting “such land management agency when such
14 agency is accepting applications from individuals
15 within the agency’s workforce under merit promotion
16 procedures, or any agency, including a land manage-
17 ment agency, when the agency is accepting applica-
18 tions from individuals outside its own workforce
19 under the merit promotion procedures of the appli-
20 cable agency”; and

21 (2) in subsection (d) by inserting “of the agen-
22 cy from which the former employee was most re-
23 cently separated” after “deemed a time-limited em-
24 ployee”.
