1 SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.

2 This Act may be cited as the "District of Columbia
3 Courts and Public Defender Service Voluntary Separation
4 Incentive Payments Act".

5 SEC. 2. AUTHORIZATION FOR PROGRAM OF VOLUNTARY 6 SEPARATION INCENTIVE PAYMENTS FOR DIS7 TRICT OF COLUMBIA COURTS.

8 (a) IN GENERAL.—Chapter 17 of title 11, District
9 of Columbia Official Code, is amended by inserting after
10 section 11–1726 the following new section:

11 "§11-1726A. Voluntary Separation Incentive Payments

"The Joint Committee on Judicial Administration 13 may, by regulation, establish a program substantially simi-14 lar to the program established under subchapter II of 15 16 chapter 35 of title 5, United States Code, for nonjudicial employees of the District of Columbia courts, except that 17 18 the maximum amount of the payment made under the pro-19 gram to any individual may not exceed the amount re-20ferred to in section 3523(b)(3)(B) of title 5, United States 21 Code.".

(b) CLERICAL AMENDMENT.—The table of contents
of chapter 17 of title 11, District of Columbia Official
Code, is amended by inserting after the item relating to
section 11–1726 the following new item:

"11–1726A. Voluntary separation incentive payments.".

SEC. 3. AUTHORIZATION FOR PROGRAM OF VOLUNTARY SEPARATION INCENTIVE PAYMENTS FOR DIS TRICT OF COLUMBIA PUBLIC DEFENDER SERVICE.

5 Section 305 of the District of Columbia Court Re6 form and Criminal Procedure Act of 1970 (sec. 2–1605,
7 D.C. Official Code) is amended by adding at the end the
8 following new subsection:

9 "(d) The Director may establish a program substan-10 tially similar to the program established under subchapter 11 II of chapter 35 of title 5, United States Code, for employ-12 ees of the Service, except that the maximum amount of 13 the payment made under the program to any individual 14 may not exceed the amount referred to in section 15 3523(b)(3)(B) of title 5, United States Code.".
