To prohibit the Secretary of Agriculture from implementing certain proposed rules on establishing criteria for imposition of fines under child nutrition programs, and for other purposes.

2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 **SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.**

4 This Act may be cited as the “Protecting School
5 Meals from Fines Act”.

6 **SEC. 2. PROHIBITION ON CERTAIN RULES.**

7 The Secretary of Education shall not implement, ad-
8 minister, or enforce sections 210.18(q), 210.26(b),

1 215.15(b), 220.18(b), 225.13(a), 225.18(k),
2 226.6(k)(2)(xii), 226.25(i), and 235.11(c) and (g) of title
3 7, Code of Federal Regulations, (relating to the imposition
4 of fines under section 22(e) of the Richard B. Russell Na-
5 tional School Lunch Act), as proposed to be added or
6 amended by the proposed regulations published by the De-
7 partment of Agriculture in the Federal Register on March
8 29, 2016 (81 Fed. Reg. 17564 et seq.).
