Mr. NEUGEBAUER introduced the following bill; which was referred to the  
Committee on Transportation and Infrastructure

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## A BILL

To deauthorize the Salt Creek project in Graham, Texas.

1       *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*  
2       *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3       **SECTION 1. SALT CREEK, GRAHAM, TEXAS.**

4       (a) IN GENERAL.—The project for flood control, envi-  
5       ronmental restoration, and recreation, Salt Creek, Gra-  
6       ham, Texas, authorized by section 101(a)(30) of the  
7       Water Resources Development Act of 1999 (Public Law  
8       106–53; 113 Stat. 278–279), is no longer authorized as  
9       a Federal project beginning on the date of enactment of  
10      this Act.

11      (b) CERTAIN PROJECT-RELATED CLAIMS.—The non-  
12      Federal sponsor for the project described in paragraph (1)

1 shall hold and save the United States harmless from any  
2 claim that has arisen, or that may arise, in connection  
3 with the project.

4 (c) TRANSFER.—The Secretary of the Army is au-  
5 thorized to transfer any land acquired by the Federal Gov-  
6 ernment for the project on behalf of the non-Federal spon-  
7 sor that remains in Federal ownership on or after the date  
8 of enactment of this Act to the non-Federal sponsor.

9 (d) REVERSION.—If the Secretary determines that  
10 the land that is integral to the project described in para-  
11 graph (1) ceases to be owned by the public, all right, title,  
12 and interest in and to the land and improvements shall  
13 revert, at the discretion of the Secretary, to the United  
14 States.

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
