A BILL

To amend the Food and Nutrition Act of 2008 to provide an incentive for households participating in the supplemental nutrition assistance program to purchase certain nutritious fruits and vegetables that are beneficial to good health.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

1 **SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.**

2 This Act may be cited as the “SNAP Healthy Incen-
3 tives Act of 2016”.

4 **SEC. 2. AMENDMENTS.**

5 (a) DEFINITION.—Section 3 of the Food and Nutri-
6 tion Act of 2008 (7 U.S.C. 2012) is amended—

7 (1) in subsection (k) by inserting “, unless the
8 context specifies otherwise,” after “means”;

9 (2) by redesignating subsections (u) and (v) as
10 subsections (v) and (w), respectively; and

11 (3) by inserting after subsection (t) the fol-
12 lowing:

13 “(u) ‘Supplemental fruits and vegetables’ means
14 those fruits and vegetables containing nutrients that pro-
15 mote the health of the population served by the supple-
16 mental nutrition assistance program, as determined by the
17 Secretary by rule.”.

18 (b) INCREASE IN VALUE OF ALLOTMENT.—Section
19 8 of the Food and Nutrition Act of 2008 (7 U.S.C. 2017)
20 is amended by adding at the end the following:

21 “(m) The value of an allotment, determined under
22 this section without regard to this subsection and issued
23 to a household for a month, shall be increased by 30 per-
24 cent of the cost of supplemental fruits and vegetables pur-
25 chased by such household during such month, but not to

1 exceed an aggregate monthly amount determined by the
2 Secretary on the basis of household size.”.

3 **SEC. 3. EFFECTIVE DATE.**

4 This Act and the amendments made by this Act shall
5 take effect on October 1, 2016.
