- 9 sales, and computer employees (81 Fed. Reg. 32552 (May
- 10 23, 2016)), such rule shall not take effect until June 1,
- 11 2017.
- 12 (b) RULE OF CONSTRUCTION.—Nothing in this Act
- 13 shall be construed to provide authority for the rule de-
- 14 scribed in subsection (a), nor any part thereof, that is not
- 15 otherwise provided by law.
