A BILL

To authorize the State of Utah to select lands that are available for disposal under the Pony Express Resource Management Plan to be used for the support and benefit of State institutions, and for other purposes.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 **SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.**

4 This Act may be cited as the “Funding Local Schools
5 Act”.

6 **SEC. 2. AUTHORIZATION.**

7 (a) IN GENERAL.—The State of Utah may select any
8 lands owned by the United States, under the administra-

1 tive jurisdiction of the Bureau of Land Management, and
2 identified as available for disposal by land exchange in the
3 Record of Decision for the Pony Express Resource Man-
4 agement Plan and Rangeland Program Summary for Utah
5 County (January 1990), as amended by the Pony Express
6 Plan Amendment (November 1997), in fulfillment of the
7 land grants made in sections 6, 8, and 12 of the Act of
8 July 16, 1894 (28 Stat. 107), without further land use
9 planning action by the Bureau of Land Management.

10 (b) APPLICATION.—The criteria listed in Decision 3
11 of the Lands Program of the resource management plan
12 described in subsection (a) shall not apply to any land se-
13 lected under subsection (a).
