Mr. SARBANES introduced the following bill; which was referred to the Committee on Oversight and Government Reform

A BILL

To amend the Presidential Transition Act of 1963 to prohibit the use of funds provided to the President-elect and the Vice President-elect under such Act for any services or facilities provided by registered lobbyists.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 **SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.**

4 This Act may be cited as the “No Lobbyists on Presi-
5 dential Transition Teams Act”.

1 **SEC. 2. PROHIBITING USE OF PRESIDENTIAL TRANSITION**
2 **FUNDS FOR SERVICES OR FACILITIES PRO-**
3 **VIDED BY LOBBYISTS.**

4 Section 3 of the Presidential Transition Act of 1963
5 (3 U.S.C. 102 note) is amended by adding at the end the
6 following new subsection:

7 “(i) No payment may be made under the authority
8 of this section for services or facilities provided by any
9 person who is a registered lobbyist under the Lobbying
10 Disclosure Act of 1995 (2 U.S.C. 1601 et seq.).”
