A BILL

To eliminate the daily newspaper cross-ownership rule of the Federal Communications Commission.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 **SECTION 1. ELIMINATION OF DAILY NEWSPAPER CROSS-**
4 **OWNERSHIP RULE.**

5 (a) NO FORCE OR EFFECT.—Paragraph (d) of sec-
6 tion 73.3555 of title 47, Code of Federal Regulations,
7 shall have no force or effect after the date of the enact-
8 ment of this Act.

1 (b) REMOVAL FROM RULES.—Not later than 1 year
2 after the date of the enactment of this Act, the Federal
3 Communications Commission shall complete all actions
4 necessary to remove such paragraph from its rules.
