3 **SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.**

4 This Act may be cited as the “Medicare Employer
5 Relief Act of 2015”.

1 **SEC. 2. REPEALING SECTION 1862(b)(5) OF THE SOCIAL SE-**
2 **CURITY ACT.**

3 (a) IN GENERAL.—Section 1862(b) of the Social Se-
4 curity Act (42 U.S.C. 1395y(b)) is amended by striking
5 paragraph (5).

6 (b) EFFECTIVE DATE.—The amendment made by
7 subsection (a) shall take effect on the date of the enact-
8 ment of this Act and shall apply to information required
9 to be provided on or after January 1, 2016.
