# **A BILL**

To designate a mountain in the John Muir Wilderness of  
the Sierra National Forest as “Sky Point”.

1       *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*  
2       *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3       **SECTION 1. FINDINGS.**

4       Congress finds the following:

5               (1) Staff Sergeant Sky Mote, USMC, grew up  
6       in El Dorado, California.

7               (2) Staff Sergeant Mote graduated from Union  
8       Mine High School.

9               (3) Upon graduation, Staff Sergeant Mote  
10      promptly enlisted in the Marine Corps.

11              (4) Staff Sergeant Mote spent 9 years serving  
12      his country in the United States Marine Corps, in-  
13      cluding a deployment to Iraq and two deployments  
14      to Afghanistan.

15              (5) By his decisive actions, heroic initiative, and  
16      resolute dedication to duty, Staff Sergeant Mote  
17      gave his life to protect fellow Marines on August 10,  
18      2012, by gallantly rushing into action during an at-  
19      tack by a rogue Afghan policeman inside the base  
20      perimeter in Helmand province.

21              (6) Staff Sergeant Mote was awarded the Navy  
22      Cross, a Purple Heart, the Navy-Marine Corps Com-  
23      mendation Medal, a Navy-Marine Corps Achieve-  
24      ment Medal, 2 Combat Action Ribbons and 3 Good  
25      Conduct Medals.

1           (7) The Congress of the United States, in ac-  
2           knowledge of this debt that cannot be repaid,  
3           honors Staff Sergeant Mote for his ultimate sacrifice  
4           and recognizes his service to his country, faithfully  
5           executed to his last, full measure of devotion.

6           (8) A presently unnamed peak in the center of  
7           Humphrey Basin holds special meaning to the  
8           friends and family of Sky Mote, as their annual  
9           hunting trips set up camp beneath this point; under  
10          the stars, the memories made beneath this rounded  
11          peak will be cherished forever.

12   **SEC. 2. SKY POINT.**

13          (a) DESIGNATION.—The mountain in the John Muir  
14          Wilderness of the Sierra National Forest in California, lo-  
15          cated at 37°15′16.10091″N 118°43′39.54102″W, shall be  
16          known and designated as “Sky Point”.

17          (b) REFERENCES.—Any reference in a law, map, reg-  
18          ulation, document, record, or other paper of the United  
19          States to the mountain described in subsection (a) shall  
20          be considered to be a reference to “Sky Point”.



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
