Mr. BURGESS, from the Committee on Rules, reported the following resolution; which was referred to the House Calendar and ordered to be printed

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## RESOLUTION

Providing for consideration of the bill (H.R. 2) to amend title XVIII of the Social Security Act to repeal the Medicare sustainable growth rate and strengthen Medicare access by improving physician payments and making other improvements, to reauthorize the Children's Health Insurance Program, and for other purposes, and providing for proceedings during the period from March 27, 2015, through April 10, 2015.

1       *Resolved*, That upon adoption of this resolution it  
2 shall be in order to consider in the House the bill (H.R.  
3 2) to amend title XVIII of the Social Security Act to re-  
4 peal the Medicare sustainable growth rate and strengthen  
5 Medicare access by improving physician payments and  
6 making other improvements, to reauthorize the Children’s  
7 Health Insurance Program, and for other purposes. All  
8 points of order against consideration of the bill are waived.  
9 The amendment printed in the report of the Committee  
10 on Rules accompanying this resolution shall be considered  
11 as adopted. The bill, as amended, shall be considered as  
12 read. All points of order against provisions in the bill, as  
13 amended, are waived. The previous question shall be con-  
14 sidered as ordered on the bill, as amended, and on any  
15 further amendment thereto, to final passage without inter-  
16 vening motion except: (1) one hour of debate equally di-  
17 vided among and controlled by the chair and ranking mi-  
18 nority member of the Committee on Energy and Com-  
19 merce and the chair and ranking minority member of the  
20 Committee on Ways and Means; and (2) one motion to  
21 recommit with or without instructions.

22       SEC. 2. On any legislative day during the period from  
23 March 27, 2015, through April 10, 2015—

24       (a) the Journal of the proceedings of the previous day  
25 shall be considered as approved; and

1 (b) the Chair may at any time declare the House ad-  
2 journed to meet at a date and time, within the limits of  
3 clause 4, section 5, article I of the Constitution, to be an-  
4 nounced by the Chair in declaring the adjournment.

5 SEC. 3. The Speaker may appoint Members to per-  
6 form the duties of the Chair for the duration of the period  
7 addressed by section 2 of this resolution as though under  
8 clause 8(a) of rule I.

9 SEC. 4. Each day during the period addressed by sec-  
10 tion 2 of this resolution shall not constitute a calendar  
11 day for purposes of section 7 of the War Powers Resolu-  
12 tion (50 U.S.C. 1546).

13 SEC. 5. The Committee on Financial Services and the  
14 Committee on Ways and Means each may, at any time  
15 before 5 p.m. on April 6, 2015, file reports to accompany  
16 measures.

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
