Mr. BYRNE, from the Committee on Rules, reported the following resolution; which was referred to the House Calendar and ordered to be printed

RESOLUTION

Providing for consideration of the bill (H.R. 1335) to amend the Magnuson-Stevens Fishery Conservation and Management Act to provide flexibility for fishery managers and stability for fishermen, and for other purposes.

1 *Resolved*, That at any time after adoption of this reso-
2 lution the Speaker may, pursuant to clause 2(b) of rule
3 XVIII, declare the House resolved into the Committee of
4 the Whole House on the state of the Union for consider-
5 ation of the bill (H.R. 1335) to amend the Magnuson-Ste-
6 vens Fishery Conservation and Management Act to pro-

1 vide flexibility for fishery managers and stability for fish-
2 ermen, and for other purposes. The first reading of the
3 bill shall be dispensed with. All points of order against
4 consideration of the bill are waived. General debate shall
5 be confined to the bill and shall not exceed one hour equal-
6 ly divided and controlled by the chair and ranking minor-
7 ity member of the Committee on Natural Resources. After
8 general debate the bill shall be considered for amendment
9 under the five-minute rule. In lieu of the amendment in
10 the nature of a substitute recommended by the Committee
11 on Natural Resources now printed in the bill, it shall be
12 in order to consider as an original bill for the purpose of
13 amendment under the five-minute rule an amendment in
14 the nature of a substitute consisting of the text of Rules
15 Committee Print 114-16. That amendment in the nature
16 of a substitute shall be considered as read. All points of
17 order against that amendment in the nature of a sub-
18 stitute are waived. No amendment to that amendment in
19 the nature of a substitute shall be in order except those
20 printed in the report of the Committee on Rules accom-
21 panying this resolution. Each such amendment may be of-
22 fered only in the order printed in the report, may be of-
23 fered only by a Member designated in the report, shall
24 be considered as read, shall be debatable for the time spec-
25 ified in the report equally divided and controlled by the

1 proponent and an opponent, may be withdrawn by the pro-
2 ponent at any time before action thereon, shall not be sub-
3 ject to amendment, and shall not be subject to a demand
4 for division of the question in the House or in the Com-
5 mittee of the Whole. All points of order against such
6 amendments are waived. At the conclusion of consider-
7 ation of the bill for amendment the Committee shall rise
8 and report the bill to the House with such amendments
9 as may have been adopted. Any Member may demand a
10 separate vote in the House on any amendment adopted
11 in the Committee of the Whole to the bill or to the amend-
12 ment in the nature of a substitute made in order as origi-
13 nal text. The previous question shall be considered as or-
14 dered on the bill and amendments thereto to final passage
15 without intervening motion except one motion to recommit
16 with or without instructions.
