## RESOLUTION

Providing for consideration of the bill (H.R. 1937) to require the Secretary of the Interior and the Secretary of Agriculture to more efficiently develop domestic sources of the minerals and mineral materials of strategic and critical importance to United States economic and national security and manufacturing competitiveness.

- 1       *Resolved*, That at any time after adoption of this reso-
- 2 lution the Speaker may, pursuant to clause 2(b) of rule
- 3 XVIII, declare the House resolved into the Committee of

1 the Whole House on the state of the Union for consider-  
2 ation of the bill (H.R. 1937) to require the Secretary of  
3 the Interior and the Secretary of Agriculture to more effi-  
4 ciently develop domestic sources of the minerals and min-  
5 eral materials of strategic and critical importance to  
6 United States economic and national security and manu-  
7 facturing competitiveness. The first reading of the bill  
8 shall be dispensed with. All points of order against consid-  
9 eration of the bill are waived. General debate shall be con-  
10 fined to the bill and shall not exceed one hour equally di-  
11 vided and controlled by the chair and ranking minority  
12 member of the Committee on Natural Resources. After  
13 general debate the bill shall be considered for amendment  
14 under the five-minute rule. The bill shall be considered  
15 as read. All points of order against provisions in the bill  
16 are waived. No amendment to the bill shall be in order  
17 except those printed in the report of the Committee on  
18 Rules accompanying this resolution. Each such amend-  
19 ment may be offered only in the order printed in the re-  
20 port, may be offered only by a Member designated in the  
21 report, shall be considered as read, shall be debatable for  
22 the time specified in the report equally divided and con-  
23 trolled by the proponent and an opponent, shall not be  
24 subject to amendment, and shall not be subject to a de-  
25 mand for division of the question in the House or in the

1 Committee of the Whole. All points of order against such  
2 amendments are waived. At the conclusion of consider-  
3 ation of the bill for amendment the Committee shall rise  
4 and report the bill to the House with such amendments  
5 as may have been adopted. The previous question shall  
6 be considered as ordered on the bill and amendments  
7 thereto to final passage without intervening motion except  
8 one motion to recommit with or without instructions.
