## RESOLUTION

Expressing the sense of the House of Representatives  
regarding an Interstate 73 corridor transportation compact.

1       *Resolved*, That it is the sense of the House of Rep-  
2       resentatives that the entering into of an agreement or  
3       compact by 2 or more States, for cooperative effort and  
4       mutual assistance, would be beneficial to the development  
5       of an Interstate 73 corridor. Such an agreement may in-  
6       corporate the following elements to the extent that such  
7       elements are consistent with Federal law and specifically

1 section 1105(e)(5) of the Intermodal Surface Transpor-  
2 tation Efficiency Act of 1991:

3 (1) Study, development, and promotion of a  
4 plan for the design, construction, financing, and op-  
5 eration of the Interstate 73 corridor through the  
6 States of South Carolina, North Carolina, Virginia,  
7 West Virginia, Ohio, and Michigan.

8 (2) Coordination of efforts to establish a com-  
9 mon legal framework in all the signatory States to  
10 authorize and facilitate design, construction, financ-  
11 ing, and operation of the Interstate 73 corridor or  
12 through public-private partnerships.

13 (3) Advocacy for Federal funding to support  
14 the establishment of the Interstate 73 corridor.

15 (4) Making available to the Interstate 73 cor-  
16 ridor project funding and resources that are or may  
17 be appropriated by the signatory States and allo-  
18 cated for that purpose.

19 (5) Doing all things necessary or convenient to  
20 facilitate and coordinate the design, construction, fi-  
21 nancing, and operation of the Interstate 73 corridor  
22 to the extent that such plans and programs are con-  
23 sistent with Federal law and the laws of the signa-  
24 tory States.
