1       *Resolved*, That—

2               (1) the House of Representatives in the Su-  
3       preme Court in the matter of United States, et al.  
4       v. Texas, et al., No. 15–674, supports the position  
5       of the petitioners; and

6               (2) the House of Representatives supports the  
7       position stated in the amicus brief filed before the  
8       U.S. Supreme Court on March 8, 2016, on behalf of

1 186 Democratic House Members and 39 Democratic  
2 Senators in support of the Obama Administration's  
3 position in United States, et al. v. Texas, et al., No.  
4 15–674, namely, that the Administration's immigra-  
5 tion executive actions are authorized by existing laws  
6 enacted by Congress and are consistent with actions  
7 taken by both Democratic and Republican presidents  
8 since the Eisenhower Administration.
