Mr. BYRNE, from the Committee on Rules, reported the following resolution; which was referred to the House Calendar and ordered to be printed

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## RESOLUTION

Providing for consideration of the bill (H.R. 5278) to establish an Oversight Board to assist the Government of Puerto Rico, including instrumentalities, in managing its public finances, and for other purposes.

1       *Resolved*, That at any time after adoption of this reso-  
2 lution the Speaker may, pursuant to clause 2(b) of rule  
3 XVIII, declare the House resolved into the Committee of  
4 the Whole House on the state of the Union for consider-  
5 ation of the bill (H.R. 5278) to establish an Oversight  
6 Board to assist the Government of Puerto Rico, including

1 instrumentalities, in managing its public finances, and for  
2 other purposes. The first reading of the bill shall be dis-  
3 pensed with. All points of order against consideration of  
4 the bill are waived. General debate shall be confined to  
5 the bill and amendments specified in this section and shall  
6 not exceed one hour equally divided and controlled by the  
7 chair and ranking minority member of the Committee on  
8 Natural Resources. After general debate the bill shall be  
9 considered for amendment under the five-minute rule. In  
10 lieu of the amendment in the nature of a substitute rec-  
11 ommended by the Committee on Natural Resources now  
12 printed in the bill, it shall be in order to consider as an  
13 original bill for the purpose of amendment under the five-  
14 minute rule an amendment in the nature of a substitute  
15 consisting of the text of Rules Committee Print 114-57.  
16 That amendment in the nature of a substitute shall be  
17 considered as read. All points of order against that amend-  
18 ment in the nature of a substitute are waived. No amend-  
19 ment to that amendment in the nature of a substitute  
20 shall be in order except those printed in the report of the  
21 Committee on Rules accompanying this resolution. Each  
22 such amendment may be offered only in the order printed  
23 in the report, may be offered only by a Member designated  
24 in the report, shall be considered as read, shall be debat-  
25 able for the time specified in the report equally divided

1 and controlled by the proponent and an opponent, shall  
2 not be subject to amendment, and shall not be subject to  
3 a demand for division of the question in the House or in  
4 the Committee of the Whole. All points of order against  
5 such amendments are waived. At the conclusion of consid-  
6 eration of the bill for amendment the Committee shall rise  
7 and report the bill to the House with such amendments  
8 as may have been adopted. Any Member may demand a  
9 separate vote in the House on any amendment adopted  
10 in the Committee of the Whole to the bill or to the amend-  
11 ment in the nature of a substitute made in order as origi-  
12 nal text. The previous question shall be considered as or-  
13 dered on the bill and amendments thereto to final passage  
14 without intervening motion except one motion to recommit  
15 with or without instructions.

16 SEC. 2. Upon passage of H.R. 5278 the House shall  
17 be considered to have: (1) stricken all after the enacting  
18 clause of S. 2328 and inserted in lieu thereof the provi-  
19 sions of H.R. 5278, as passed by the House; and (2)  
20 passed the Senate bill as so amended.

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
