Mr. TOOMEY introduced the following bill; which was read twice and referred to the Committee on the Judiciary

A BILL

To amend title 18, United States Code, to provide additional aggravating factors for the imposition of the death penalty based on the status of the victim.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 **SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.**

4 This Act may be cited as the “Thin Blue Line Act”.

5 **SEC. 2. AGGRAVATING FACTORS FOR DEATH PENALTY.**

6 Section 3592(c) of title 18, United States Code, is
7 amended by inserting after paragraph (16) the following:

8 “(17) KILLING OR TARGETING OF LAW EN-
9 FORCEMENT OFFICER.—

1 “(A) The defendant killed or attempted to
2 kill, in the circumstance described in subpara-
3 graph (B), a person who is authorized by law—

4 “(i) to engage in or supervise the pre-
5 vention, detention, investigation, or pros-
6 ecution, or the incarceration of any person
7 for any criminal violation of law;

8 “(ii) to apprehend, arrest, or pros-
9 ecute an individual for any criminal viola-
10 tion of law; or

11 “(iii) to be a firefighter or other first
12 responder.

13 “(B) The circumstance referred to in sub-
14 paragraph (A) is that the person was killed or
15 targeted—

16 “(i) while he or she was engaged in
17 the performance of his or her official du-
18 ties;

19 “(ii) because of the performance of his
20 or her official duties; or

21 “(iii) because of his or her status as
22 a public official or employee.”.
