Mr. BURR (for himself and Mr. TILLIS) introduced the following bill; which was read twice and referred to the Committee on Energy and Natural Resources

A BILL

To extend the deadline for commencement of construction of a hydroelectric project.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 **SECTION 1. EXTENSION OF DEADLINE FOR HYDRO-**
4 **ELECTRIC PROJECT.**

5 (a) IN GENERAL.—Notwithstanding the time period
6 specified in section 13 of the Federal Power Act (16
7 U.S.C. 806) that would otherwise apply to the Federal En-
8 ergy Regulatory Commission project numbered 12642, the
9 Commission may, at the request of the licensee for the
10 project, and after reasonable notice, in accordance with

1 the good faith, due diligence, and public interest require-
 2 ments of that section and the procedures of the Commis-
 3 sion under that section, extend the time period during
 4 which the licensee is required to commence the construc-
 5 tion of the project for up to 3 consecutive 2-year periods
 6 from the date of the expiration of the extension originally
 7 issued by the Commission.

8 (b) REINSTATEMENT OF EXPIRED LICENSE.—If the
 9 period required for commencement of construction of the
 10 project described in subsection (a) has expired prior to the
 11 date of enactment of this Act—

12 (1) the Federal Energy Regulatory Commission
 13 may reinstate the license effective as of the date of
 14 the expiration of the license; and

15 (2) the first extension authorized under sub-
 16 section (a) shall take effect on that expiration date.
