A BILL

To require the Secretary of State to offer rewards of not less than \$10,000,000 for information that leads to the arrest or conviction of suspects in connection with the bombing of Pan Am Flight 103.

2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 **SECTION 1. REWARDS AUTHORIZED.**

4 In accordance with the Rewards for Justice program
5 authorized under section 36(b) of the State Department
6 Basic Authorities Act of 1956 (22 U.S.C. 2708(b)), the
7 Secretary of State shall offer a reward of not less than
8 \$10,000,000 to any individual who furnishes information

- 1 leading to the arrest or conviction in any country of any
- 2 individual responsible for the 1988 bombing of Pan Am
- 3 Flight 103.
