3 **SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.**

4 This Act may be cited as the “Driver Fatigue Preven-
5 tion Act”.

6 **SEC. 2. AMENDMENT TO THE FAIR LABOR STANDARDS ACT**
7 **OF 1938.**

8 Section 13(b)(1) of the Fair Labor Standards Act of
9 1938 (29 U.S.C. 213(b)(1)) is amended by inserting be-

1 fore the semicolon the following: “, except a driver of an
2 ‘over-the-road bus’ as defined in section 3038(a)(3) of the
3 Transportation Equity Act for the 21st Century (Public
4 Law 105–178; 49 U.S.C. 5310 note)”.
